BAC Background Requirements

Prospective BAC members will require both a State (DPS) and National (FBI) Criminal History Report.

Before the Texas Lottery Commission (TLC) Enforcement staff can receive the DPS and FBI Criminal History reports, all prospective BAC applicants will require fingerprinting and consent to the fingerprints being provided to DPS and the FBI for criminal history check.

When provided the name and contact information (phone number and email address), a Background Investigator will contact the applicant and provide: instructions for scheduling fingerprinting, a Consent to Background Investigation Form, and information regarding acceptable types of identification required at the time of fingerprinting.

Instructions for fingerprinting will be provided to applicants. Applicants residing in the Austin area may schedule fingerprinting at the Texas Lottery Commission. In doing so, Applicants will not incur a fingerprinting fee. Applicants outside the Austin area will need to schedule fingerprinting at an IdentoGO fingerprinting site. Applicants fingerprinted at an IdentoGO site will be required to cover the cost of fingerprinting.

Fingerprints of Applicants fingerprinted at the Texas Lottery Commission or at the IdentoGo site will be submitted by IdentoGo to DPS and FBI. DPS and FBI criminal histories should be received by the Texas Lottery Commission Enforcement Division one to two days after fingerprint submission. Completed consent forms along with photo copies of acceptable identification and social security card will be mailed to the assigned Background Investigator.

The assigned Background Investigator will stay in contact with the BAC applicant to assist with any issues that may arise.

Privacy Statement

The Charitable Bingo Operations Division of the Texas Lottery Commission requests the information for the purpose of selecting eligible members for the BAC. Any personally identifiable information provided by you shall be used for the purpose of selecting BAC members. Except as required by law as is explained further below, we will not share any personally identifiable information we gather about you with anyone else. The information we collect will be retained and maintained as required by Texas records retention laws (Government Code, Section 441.180 et. seq.) and rules. Different types of information are required to be kept for different periods of time. The information provided in this form is subject to release upon request pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 552, which provides public access to certain government records.
