Please note that each nominee must meet the minimum eligibility requirements stated in Texas Bingo Rule §402.102, as well as the criminal history standards in the Bingo Enabling Act §§2001.105(b), 2002.154(a)(1), 2001.202(1), 2001.207(1), and Texas Bingo Rule §402.102. Specifically, the Commission may not appoint a nominee who has a previous conviction for criminal fraud (Texas Penal Code Chapters 32 and 35) or a gambling or gambling-related offense.
