# TONIGHT'S POWERBALL ${ }^{\circledR}$ JACKPOT STANDS AT \$550 MILLION 

## Ninth largest jackpot prize in game history;

Mega Millions ${ }^{\circledR}$ jackpot rolls to an estimated annuitized $\$ 750$ million for Friday night’s drawing
(AUSTIN) - Jackpot excitement continues to build! After there were no winners for last night's Mega Millions ${ }^{\circledR}$ jackpot drawing, Texas Lottery ${ }^{\circledR}$ players have their eyes set on the Powerball ${ }^{\circledR}$ jackpot, which offers an estimated annuitized $\$ 550$ million jackpot prize - the ninth largest in game history - for the Wednesday, Jan. 13 drawing. The prize up for grabs started as an estimated annuitized $\$ 20$ million for the drawing on Sept. 19, 2020 and is the result of 33 draws without a winner. The cash value for tonight's jackpot is an estimated $\$ 411.4$ million, which is ranked seventh all-time in U.S. lottery history. With the Mega Millions jackpot rolling to an estimated annuitized $\$ 750$ million for the Friday, Jan. 15 drawing - the fifth largest jackpot in U.S. lottery history - the two multijurisdictional games now combine for more than $\$ 1.3$ billion in jackpot prizes.
"With both the Powerball and Mega Millions jackpot levels among the top 10 largest in each game's respective history, we are hoping that at least one of them will be won by a Texas Lottery player," said Gary Grief, executive director of the Texas Lottery. "These jackpots are giving lottery players an opportunity to daydream about what they may do if they win, which is a welcomed break for many. While it's an exciting time to play, we want to remind our players to play responsibly. It only takes one ticket to win."

Tonight's drawing coincides with the fifth anniversary of Powerball's world record $\$ 1.586$ billion jackpot that was hit on Jan. 13, 2016. The record jackpot was shared by three out-of-state winners. Since joining the game in 2010, Texas has had two Powerball jackpot winners, including its most recent in February 2015 when TL Management Trust, Andrew Weber, Trustee of Austin, claimed a share of the $\$ 564.1$ million jackpot prize with two out-of-state winners.

Since the start of 2020, nine Texas Lottery players have won second-tier Powerball prizes of $\$ 1$ million or larger, including three during the current jackpot run. Most recently, on Jan. 6, a Texas Lottery player won a second-tier Powerball prize of $\$ 1$ million; the ticket was sold in Houston.

Powerball jackpots start at $\$ 20$ million and roll until the jackpot is won. Players win the jackpot by matching five numbers from a field of 69 numbers and one Powerball number from a field of 26 numbers. By choosing the Power Play ${ }^{\circledR}$ for $\$ 1$ more per play, players can multiply their non-jackpot winnings by two, three, four, five or 10 times*. A Power Play Match Five (5+0) is set at $\$ 2,000,000$ regardless of the Power Play number selected. All other non-grand prizes will be multiplied by the Power Play number selected. *The 10X Power Play multiplier is available for drawings in which the initially advertised annuitized Grand Prize amount is $\$ 150$ million or less. Drawings are broadcast each Wednesday and Saturday at 10:12 p.m. CT. Ticket sales for the next Powerball drawing will close at 9 p.m. CT on Wednesday. Texas Lottery players can purchase Powerball tickets at more than 20,000 Texas Lottery retailers across the state.
