FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Can I pay lottery prizes to a person under the age of 18?

A. Retailers may pay prizes only to a person 18 or older. You are not authorized to pay prizes to an adult who is presenting a prize winning ticket on behalf of a person who is under the age of 18. An adult member of the minor's family or the minor's guardian must claim the prize on the minor's behalf at a claim center. Remember, you many only conduct lottery transactions with adults.

Q. Is it against the law to sell tickets to a person under the age of 18?

A. Yes. It is a criminal offense (Class C misdemeanor) to knowingly sell or offer to sell a lottery ticket to a person younger than 18 years of age. Also, if a person younger than 18 years of age purchases a lottery ticket, they are committing a criminal offense.
