HOW IT WORKS:

Vouchers will be generated based on your sales efforts!

Every time you sell eight (8) *Texas Two Step*® tickets worth \$5 or more, a prize voucher will print from the terminal.

Sign the voucher and give it to your Lottery Sales Representative (LSR) to claim your Texas Lottery® t-shirt.

REDEMPTION:

Clerk voucher promotion runs April 1 through April 30, or while supplies last.

Vouchers cannot be redeemed at Texas Lottery claim centers or by mail.

Signed vouchers must be redeemed with your LSR by June 28, 2024.

Place TRY ME! stickers at the top of bins for RCIP games \$200,000 WINNINGS and \$1,000,000 WINNINGS.

REMINDER: All retailers should have at least one veterans' ticket displayed at all times.

SECONDARY #920 ENDED MARCH 23

- Drawing planned for **April 9**, results after **April 15**.
- Payments planned for **May 3**. Tickets deliver by **May 24**.

SECONDARY #921 RUNS MARCH 24 – MAY 4

- Sell one or a combination of selected games to reach 10-pack threshold.
- If you earn packs but don't maintain your license after **May 4**, contact IGT district office by **May 9** to claim packs.

PRIMARY #43 ENDED MARCH 30

- Drawings planned for **April 23**. Payments scheduled for **May 10**.

PRIMARY #44 RUNS APRIL 21 – AUGUST 17

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What are the acceptable forms of payment for Texas Lottery® tickets?

A. Retailers may only accept debit cards, cash, checks or Texas Lottery-issued coupons and vouchers as payment for lottery tickets. It is a criminal offense to accept any other form of payment. Also, retailers cannot require a minimum purchase to use a debit card for lottery purchases.

Q. If a customer is paying for other items with a credit card, can they add lottery to the transaction?

A. No. Lottery tickets can never be purchased with a credit card. It is a retailer violation to do so. Penalties range from a 10–90 day license suspension or revocation for first occurrence to license revocation for third offense.

CREDIT CARDS ARE NEVER ACCEPTABLE FOR TEXAS LOTTERY PURCHASES.
