RETAILER CASH INCENTIVE PROGRAM (RCIP)

If you earned free packs in RCIP #909 Scratch Ticket Promotion that ended Oct. 17, your packs should be delivered by Dec. 24.

Drawings for RCIP #33 that ended Nov. 21 are planned for Dec. 15. Payments for base program and drawings are scheduled for release Dec. 28. Confirm receipt date with your bank.

RCIP #34 starts Jan. 3. Reps will deliver flyers with goals Nov. 30 – Dec. 27.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Is it against the law to sell tickets to a person under the age of 18?

A. Yes. It is a criminal offense (Class C misdemeanor) to knowingly sell or offer to sell a lottery ticket to a person younger than 18 years of age. Also, if a person younger than 18 years of age purchases a lottery ticket, they are committing a criminal offense. Some retailers check a player's ID to avoid selling tickets to minors.

Q. What do I do if I think a minor is attempting to purchase tickets at the lottery self-service vending machine?

A. Every retail location equipped with a lottery ticket vending machine is provided with a remote shut-off device to allow for the control of sales transactions. Remember, you may only conduct lottery transactions with adults.
