RETAILER CASH INCENTIVE PROGRAM (RCIP)

WHAT DO THE RCIP TERMINAL REPORT NUMBERS MEAN?

MINIMUM GOAL: Minimum required sales to earn payment & first drawing entry; does not change

SALES TO DATE: As of previous week ending Saturday; updated weekly

BALANCE NEEDED TO MAKE GOAL: Minimum Goal minus Sales to Date; updated weekly

POTENTIAL CASH: Once Minimum Goal is met; updated weekly

POTENTIAL ENTRIES: Once Minimum Goal is met; updated weekly

POTENTIAL BONUS ENTRIES: For FIREBALL sales during the RCIP once Minimum Goal is met; updated weekly

POTENTIAL TOTAL ENTRIES: Sum of all entries; updated weekly

WKLY SALE AVG TO MAKE GOAL: Balance Needed to Make Goal divided by weeks remaining; updated weekly

EST ADJUSTED PYMT: Final audited payment to retailer's lottery bank sweep account; may change with audit

Terminal and LSP reports display final results of previous RCIP until 2nd week of current RCIP.
