## CLAIMS UP TO \$5 MILLION

Effective January 6, players may claim prizes up to and including \$5 million at claim centers in Austin, Dallas, Fort Worth, Houston and San Antonio.

Prizes up to \$2.5 million can be claimed at any claim center. Prizes greater than \$5 million, all *Lotto Texas®*, *Powerball®* and *Mega Millions®* jackpot prizes, and prizes paid through an annuity must be claimed at the Texas Lottery® headquarters in Austin.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### Q. What pack settlement irregularities could result in disqualification from the RCIP?

A. The following examples are just some of the scenarios for disqualification.

- Settling packs in order to inflate a retailer's sales toward reaching their goal and then not offering those games for sale.
- Settling packs, not selling them and holding on to them for game close or after end of RCIP.
- Selling packs at a store other than the store to which they are assigned.
