RETAILER CASH INCENTIVE PROGRAM (RCIP)

OVER \$180 MILLION PAID TO RETAILERS!

RCIP #30 ended November 23

- Payments to retailers' lottery bank sweep account planned for Jan. 10.
- Drawing results are posted at txlottery.org on the Retailers page.

RCIP #31: January 5 – April 4

- Know your sales goal.
- Review flyer details with your LSR.
- Use your terminal or LSP report to track your weekly sales needed to make your goal.

The flyer is titled "Meeting Your Minimum Sales Goal" and includes a form for tracking sales. It specifies the "Minimum Sales Goal" as "EP or AEP Weekly Sales Average" and provides instructions on how to track progress using a terminal or LSP report. The flyer also includes a section for "Incentive Sales Include" and "How to Track Your Progress".

This information provides retailers key elements of the RCIP. It is not a comprehensive description of the entire program. CLAIMS UP TO \$5 MILLION

Effective January 6, players may claim prizes up to and including \$5 million at claim centers in Austin, Dallas, Fort Worth, Houston and San Antonio.

Prizes up to \$2.5 million can be claimed at any claim center. Prizes greater than \$5 million, all *Lotto Texas*®, *Powerball*® and *Mega Millions*® jackpot prizes, and prizes paid through an annuity must be claimed at the Texas Lottery® headquarters in Austin.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What pack settlement irregularities could result in disqualification from the RCIP?

A. The following examples are just some of the scenarios for disqualification.

- Settling packs in order to inflate a retailer's sales toward reaching their goal and then not offering those games for sale.
- Settling packs, not selling them and holding on to them for game close or after end of RCIP.
- Selling packs at a store other than the store to which they are assigned.
