**Avoid Texas Lottery® Retailer Violations** 

#### Here is a common one to avoid:

Licensee and/or its employee(s) exhibit discourteous treatment including, but not limited to, abusive language toward customers, commission employees or commission vendors. [16 TAC §401.160(h)(5)]

- You are expected to treat lottery customers, lottery employees and lottery vendors courteously.
- You can expect courteous treatment from lottery employees and our vendors.
- Exhibiting discourteous treatment is a lottery violation and can result in penalties.
- Penalties range from Warning Letters to License Suspension or Revocation.
