YOU ARE IMPORTANT TO US! Avoid Texas Lottery® Retailer Violations

Here is a common one to avoid:

Licensee intentionally or knowingly sells a ticket at a price the licensee knows is greater than the price set by the executive director. [16 TAC §401.158(b)(23)]

- Texas Lottery retailers may not charge more than the price printed on the ticket.
- Retailers may not charge a fee for lottery ticket purchases using a debit card.
- Retailers may require a minimum dollar amount for debit card purchases if the minimum applies to all products, but may not require a minimum amount for purchases of *only* lottery tickets.
- Penalties range from License Suspension to Revocation.
