TRACK YOUR PROGRESS

MINIMUM GOAL: Minimum required sales to earn payment and first drawing entry; does not change

SALES TO DATE: As of previous week ending Saturday; updated weekly

BALANCE NEEDED TO MAKE GOAL: Minimum Goal minus Sales to Date; updated weekly

POTENTIAL CASH: Once Minimum Goal is met; updated weekly

POTENTIAL ENTRIES: Once Minimum Goal is met; updated weekly

POTENTIAL BONUS ENTRIES: For Pick 3™ and FIREBALL on Pick 3™ in RCIP once Minimum Goal is met; updated weekly

POTENTIAL TOTAL ENTRIES: Sum of all entries; updated weekly

WKLY SALE AVG TO MAKE GOAL: Balance Needed to Make Goal divided by weeks remaining; updated weekly

EST ADJUSTED PYMT: Final audited payment; does not change

RETAILER BONUS PROGRAM

Eligible retailers receive a \$250,000 bonus when they sell a Mega Millions® or Powerball® jackpot prize-winning ticket. Bonus is pari-mutuel.

This is the first step in expanding bonuses to other Texas Lottery® games in 2026!

- The Texas Lottery has a limited budget of \$2.01 million for retailer bonus payments September 1, 2025 – August 31, 2026, and may change the criteria for earning a bonus payment over that period.
- If at any point during the fiscal year the total amount of bonuses exceeds the appropriated budget amount, the program will be automatically suspended for the remainder of the fiscal year so that bonus payments do not exceed the total program budget.

YOU ARE IMPORTANT TO US!

Avoid this common Texas Lottery® Retailer Rules violation:

A retailer is not authorized to pay a prize claimed by a minor. [16 TAC §401.302(g)(5) and §401.304(g)(5)]

- Texas Lottery retailers may pay prizes only to adults (18 or older).
- Retailers are **not** authorized to pay prizes to an adult who is presenting a prize-winning ticket on behalf of a minor (under 18).
- Penalties range from **Warning Letters** to **License Suspension** (10-90 days) to **License Revocation**.
