New Retailer Bonus Program

The 86th Legislature restored funding for retailer bonuses at an appropriation of \$2.019 million for FY 2020. The Texas Lottery introduced a new bonus structure September 1, 2019, based on that appropriation.

This information is provided to inform retailers of the Texas Lottery Commission's retailer bonus program. It is not a comprehensive description of the entire program. All Texas Lottery Commission directives, policies, procedures, rules and regulations apply.

*The Texas Lottery has a limited budget for retailer bonus payments in each fiscal year. Bonus payments will be made in full to eligible retailers as long as sufficient funds remain in the retailer bonus budget. When the funds near depletion, a retailer selling a *Powerball*[®] or *Mega Millions*[®] jackpot-winning ticket may receive **less than** one percent of the portion of the jackpot won in Texas based on the balance remaining in the retailer bonus budget. Payments are made based on the sequence of the draw date. If the retailer bonus budget becomes depleted, no additional retailer bonus payments will be made for the remainder of the fiscal year.

**If multiple jackpot-winning tickets are sold by more than one Texas Lottery[®] retailer, the bonus will be divided equally between the retailers, up to a maximum of \$1 million for any drawing. Note: "Jackpot" refers to the Grand Prize in the *Powerball* and *Mega Millions* games.
